Bi-Weekly Project Update
March 16 – 28, 2015

DOT Project: 0092-0522

Rehabilitation of Bridge No. 00163A, I-95 over West River and SR 745 in the towns of West Haven and New Haven.

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Interstate Impacts:

- There is no regularly scheduled night work for this two week update except for emergency pot hole repairs.

Local Roads Impacts:

- Installation of the noise barrier wall along the new on-ramp from Ella Grasso Boulevard to I-95 NB.
- Excavation and demolition of substructure of existing I-95 NB Bridge over Ella Grasso Boulevard and installation of piles for the new bridge.
- Installation of drainage on Ella Grasso Boulevard.
- Installation of deck pans for new bridge over the West River.
- Construction of temporary Ramp "A" for I-95 NB.

Potential Vibration/Noise Construction Activities:

- Daytime and nighttime activities that may create vibrations and/or noise are scheduled to occur throughout the period from Monday, March 16, 2015 to Saturday, March 28, 2015.

Ramp Closure Announcement:

- Starting April 21, 2015 the I-95 SB Exit 44 loop ramp will be closed.

Work Zone Safe Driving Tip:

In addition to other warning signs, a "flagger ahead" warning sign may be posted in the work zone. When you see this, stay alert and be prepared to obey the flagger's directions. In a work zone, a flagger has the same **authority as a regulatory sign**. so you can be

Why is a new Bridge being built?

Built in 1958, the bridge has weathered over 50 years of unforgiving New England weather and continually growing traffic (approximately 135,000 cars and trucks per day!). The Bridge must be replaced to continue to support the growing traffic demands of this crossing of the West River.

What is involved in the construction of the bridge?

Prior to construction of the bridge work construction of a temporary work trestle over water and wetlands will be erected. This will allow access to construct the substructure/piers. The 5 new piers for the Bridge rest on driven concrete piles. Concrete substructures rest on the pile groups and the structural steel superstructure is placed on the piers followed by a concrete deck and asphalt overlay.

When will bridge construction be complete?

Construction is currently scheduled for completion in Fall 2018.



The Connecticut Department of Transportation is announcing that a new on-ramp configuration to I-95 Northbound, Exit 45 new Interchange is now open as of Saturday, November 22, 2014, in the towns of New Haven and West Haven. Traffic revisions on November 26, 2014: The existing on-ramp from Kimberly Avenue to I-95 NB has been permanently closed. Traffic from Kimberly Avenue to I-95 NB has been diverted to the new on-ramp to I-95 NB on Ella T. Grasso Boulevard via an extension to Ella T. Grasso Boulevard. Permanent signage has been installed guiding traffic from Kimberly Avenue to the new on-ramp.
