Rehabilitation of Bridge No. 00163A, I-95 over West River and State Route 745 in the Towns of West Haven and New Haven

INTERSTATE IMPACTS:

- None Scheduled.

LOCAL ROAD IMPACTS:

- Construction of noise wall along I-95 southbound, Exit 44 Ramp.
- Demolition of the existing I-95 SB Bridge over the West River.
- Installation of piles for foundations of new Bridge No. 163 over the West River.

POTENTIAL VIBRATION/NOISE CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES:

- Daytime activities that may create vibrations and/or noise are scheduled to occur throughout the period from Monday, November 23, 2015 to Saturday, December 5, 2015.

WORK ZONE SAFE DRIVING TIPS:

- Dedicate your **full** attention to the roadway.
- Avoid changing the radio station, using a phone, eating or any other distraction that can remove your concentration from the road.
- "Listen to the signs"
- Watch brake lights on vehicles ahead.
- Merge well before you reach the lane closure.
- Be aware that traffic patterns can change daily.
- Follow vehicles at a safe distance.
- Workers, work vehicles, equipment may enter your lane.
